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### **Exploring Shapes - Mensa for Kids**

Grow the Shape is a super fun composing shapes activity to keep . included in my First Grade Math Unit 17 and "Composing Shapes" is only.

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Are there more parallelograms or pentagons? Can your kid trace, color, and identify these three-dimensional shapes? I just love sharing ideas and get excited and then these posts end up being a million uses. They can build it with blocks first on their paper then trace and color. Assessment strategies and rubrics are included at the end of each section. Go back and try. I recommend printing out the color version of these mats and either laminating them or putting them in a sheet protector like I did above and having students use a dry erase marker to write on. Let them get those pieces on the paper and build it to figure out the new composite shape.
