Lincoln responded three days later with his own note. The Liberal Republican national convention met in Cincinnati in May. However, only two of the children lived into adulthood. I do not intrude to tell you—for you must know already—that a great proportion of the children of the South were born in the North. As a newspaper editor, politician, and reformer, Greeley was involved with the major trends of the era. Greeley soon suffered a mental breakdown and was hospitalized. During his campaign for the presidency Republicans had ridiculed him for his clothes, shambling gait, and absent-minded manner and portrayed him as a traitor for his earlier criticisms of President Lincoln as a fool, an ignoramus, and a crank, weak in judgment and nerve. The Tribune was initially in favor of peaceful separation, with the South becoming a separate nation. Greeley was a partner in the firm of

Brace and Company.
